6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 3.2-6511 of the Code of Virginia, relating to pet shops; notice of deceased
7	animals.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 3.2-6511 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 3.2-6511. Failure of dealer or pet shop to provide adequate care; penalty; report.
11	A. Any dealer or pet shop that fails to adequately house, feed, water, exercise or care for animals
12	in his or its possession or custody as provided for under this chapter is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
13	Such animals shall be subject to seizure and impoundment, and upon conviction of such person the animals
14	may be sold, euthanized, or disposed of as provided by § 3.2-6546 for licensed, tagged, or tattooed
15	animals. Such failure is also grounds for revocation of a permit or certificate of registration after public
16	hearing. Any funds that result from such sale shall be used first to pay the costs of the local jurisdiction
17	for the impoundment and disposition of the animals, and any funds remaining shall be paid to the owner,
18	if known. If the owner is not found, the remaining funds shall be paid into the Literary Fund
19	B. Pet shops shall retain records indicating any time a dog, cat, or rabbit in its possession or custody
20	dies or is euthanized. Such records shall be (i) maintained for a period of at least two years, (ii) available
21	to animal control officers and the Inspector, and (iii) reported annually, in a manner prescribed by the
22	Department, by the Inspector to the Department.
