6	A BILL to require the Department of Special Education and Student Services at the Department of
7	Education to convene a work group to provide input and recommendations relating to the

9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. The Department of Special Education and Student Services at the Department of Education shall
11	convene a work group consisting of students who use accessible technology, parents of students who use
12	accessible technology, teachers, special education administrators, division superintendents, school
13	principals, representatives of school boards, representatives of disability advocacy groups, representatives
14	of education technology vendors, representatives of firms or organizations that provide accessibility
15	testing and that have proven expertise in the evaluation of education technology, representatives of special
16	education teacher training programs with an advanced background in visual impairment, and any other
17	stakeholder that it deems appropriate to provide input and recommendations to the Department of
18	Education, the Board of Education, and the General Assembly no later than November 1, 2022, regarding
19	(i) ways in which school divisions can effectively identify and receive responsive and responsible bids
20	from vendors to procure digital tools, including online platforms, courses, digital applications, information
21	and communication technology services, and digital content, that comply with the accessibility standard,
22	as that term is defined in § 508(a)(2) of the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, 29 U.S.C. § 794d(a)(2),
23	and (ii) any statutory or regulatory changes that may assist school divisions to procure such digital tools
24	that comply with the accessibility standard.
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
