5 6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 23.1-904 of the Code of Virginia, relating to public institutions of higher
7	education; academic credit; education, experience, training, and credentials in Armed Forces of

9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 23.1-904 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 23.1-904. Course credit; veterans; active duty military students.
12	A. The governing board of each public institution of higher education shall implement policies
13	that provide students called to active military duty during an academic semester with the opportunity to
14	earn full course credit. Such policies shall provide, as one option, that such students who have completed
15	75 percent of the course requirements at the time of activation and who meet other specified requirements
16	receive full course credit.
17	B. The governing board of each public institution of higher education shall, in accordance with
18	guidelines developed by the Council, implement policies for the purpose of awarding academic credit to
19	students for educational education, experience, training, and credentials gained from service in the Armed
20	Forces of the United States.
21	C. The governing board of each public institution of higher education shall, in accordance with
22	guidelines developed by the Council, implement policies that recognize the scheduling difficulties and
23	obligations encountered by active duty members of the Armed Forces of the United States.
24	2. That the governing board of each public institution of higher education shall map the existing
25	opportunities to earn education, experience, training, and credentials in the Armed Forces of the
26	United States to the award of academic credit in its programs. The State Council of Higher

27	Education shall update its guidelines developed pursuant to subsection B of § 23.1-904 of the Code
28	of Virginia, as amended by this act, no later than February 1, 2023, and the governing board of each
29	public institution of higher education shall update its policies implemented pursuant to subsection
30	B of § 23.1-904 of the Code of Virginia, as amended by this act, no later than the beginning of the
31	2023–2024 academic year.
