| 10 | 1. That § 18.2-151.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:                            |
| 11 | § 18.2-151.1. Injuring, destroying, removing, or tampering with firefighting or emergency                    |
| 12 | medical services equipment or law-enforcement equipment or vehicles; penalty.                                |
| 13 | Any person who injures, destroys, removes, tampers with, or otherwise interferes with the                    |
| 14 | operation of (i) any equipment or apparatus used for fighting fires or for protecting property or human life |
| 15 | by a fire company or fire department, as those terms are defined in § 27-6.01,-or (ii) any equipment or      |
| 16 | vehicle used by emergency medical services personnel, as defined in § 32.1-111.1, or (iii) any emergency     |
| 17 | medical services vehicle, as defined in § 32.1-111.1, equipment or vehicle used by law-enforcement           |
| 18 | officers intending to temporarily or permanently prevent the useful operation of such equipment, vehicle,    |
| 19 | or apparatus is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor Class 6 felony.  |
| 20 | 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or                |
| 21 | commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary           |
| 22 | appropriation is for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities;                         |
| 23 | therefore, Chapter 552 of the Acts of Assembly of 2021, Special Session I, requires the Virginia             |
| 24 | Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-              |
| 25 | 19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is for                   |
| 26 | periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.                                  |

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
