7	746.2:2, 46.2-746.2:3, 46.2-746.2:4, 46.2-746.2:6, 46.2-746.3, 46.2-746.5, and 46.2-749.46 of the
8	Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates; military service; unremarried surviving
9	spouses.
10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That §§ 46.2-740, 46.2-741, 46.2-742.4, 46.2-743, 46.2-744, 46.2-746.1, 46.2-746.2:2, 46.2-746.2:3,
11	46.2-746.2:4, 46.2-746.2:6, 46.2-746.3, 46.2-746.5, and 46.2-749.46 of the Code of Virginia are
12	amended and reenacted as follows:
14	§ 46.2-740. Special license plates for survivors of Battle of Chosin Reservoir.
15	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a survivor of the Battle of
16	Chosin Reservoir, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the applicant.
17	The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license
18	plates issued under this section.
19	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
20	section may also be issued special license plates under this section.
21	§ 46.2-741. Special license plates for survivors of attack on Pearl Harbor; fees.
22	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
23	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States and, while serving in the armed forces of
24	the United States, was present during the attack on the island of Oahu, Territory of Hawaii, on December
25	7, 1941, between the hours of 7:55 a.m. and 9:45 a.m., Hawaii time, the Commissioner shall issue to the
26	applicant special license plates identifying the vehicle as registered to a Pearl Harbor survivor.

27	For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition
28	to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are issued.
29	The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license
30	plates issued under this section.
31	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
32	section may also be issued special license plates under this section.
33	§ 46.2-742.4. Special license plates for persons awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge.
34	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Combat
35	Infantryman Badge, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.
36	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
37	section may also be issued special license plates under this section.
38	§ 46.2-743. Special license plates for active duty members of the armed forces of the United
39	States and certain veterans; fees.
40	A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
41	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
42	applicant special license plates. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special
43	license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.
44	B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
45	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United
46	States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
47	incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons
48	eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates
49	under this subsection.
50	C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has

On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has 51 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United 52 States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design 53 incorporates an emblem of the United States Army. <u>Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to</u> 54 receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this
55 subsection.

D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United States Coast Guard, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design incorporates an emblem of the United States Coast Guard. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

62 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has 63 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United 64 States Navy, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design 65 incorporates an emblem of the United States Navy. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to 66 receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this 67 subsection. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this subsection shall be \$25 in addition to the 68 prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations 69 pursuant to this subsection, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting 70 fund known as the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society Fund established within the Department of 71 Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society and used to support 72 its operation and programs in Virginia. All other fees imposed under the provisions of this subsection shall 73 be paid to, and received by, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles and paid by him into 74 the state treasury and set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the necessary expenses incurred by the 75 Department of Motor Vehicles.

F. All special license plates that have been developed and issued pursuant to subsection B, C, D,
or E shall also be issued to applicants who can provide documentation from the U.S. Department of
Veterans Affairs indicating that the applicant has been designated disabled, and that his disability is
service-connected, and that he has been honorably discharged from a branch of the armed forces of the
United States.

81 G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War 82 II, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license 83 plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of 84 state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued. Unremarried surviving spouses 85 of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection. 86 87 H. 113	N. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
114	Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans
115	of those military operations. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license
116	plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.
117	O. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued
118	under subsections G, H, J, K, L, M, and N.
119	§ 46.2-744. Special license plates for members of National Guard; fees.
120	On receipt of an application and written confirmation that the applicant is a member of the National
121	Guard, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.
122	No fee shall be charged for license plates issued under this section to a member of the Virginia
123	National Guard for any one motor vehicle owned and used personally by the applicant, unless the plates
124	bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for in § 46.2-726. In this latter case, the fee for the issuance
125	of license plates shall be the same as for those issued under § 46.2-726. For each additional set of license
126	plates issued to an applicant under this section, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed fee for state
127	license plates.

141	of territory under the control of enemy forces.

144	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
145	section may also be issued special license plates under this section.
