7	dwelling or occupied building by electronic device; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-130.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-130.1. Peeping or spying into dwelling or occupied building by electronic device;
11	penalty.
12	It is unlawful for any person to knowingly and intentionally cause an electronic device to enter the
13	property of another to secretly or furtively peep or spy or attempt to peep or spy into or through a window,
14	door, or other aperture of any building, structure, or other enclosure occupied or intended for occupancy
15	as a dwelling, whether or not such building, structure, or enclosure is permanently situated or transportable
16	and whether or not such occupancy is permanent or temporary, or to do the same, without just cause, upon
17	property owned by him and leased or rented to another under circumstances that would violate the
18	occupant's reasonable expectation of privacy. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor. The
19	provisions of this section shall not apply to a lawful criminal investigation.
