6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 17.1-905 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Judicial Inquiry and Review
7	Commission; annual report; breach of Canons of Judicial Conduct; disciplinary action.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 17.1-905 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 17.1-905. Annual report.
11	On or before December 1 of each year, the Commission shall publish a report detailing the
12	activities of the Commission for the prior year. The report shall include the number of complaints filed
13	with the Commission; the number of complaints originating from attorneys, judges, court employees, or
14	the general public; the number of complaints dismissed based on (i) failure to fall within the jurisdiction
15	of the Commission, (ii) failure to state a violation of the Canons of Judicial Conduct, or (iii) failure of the
16	Commission to reach a conclusion that the Canons were breached; the number of complaints for which
17	the Commission concluded that the Canons of Judicial Conduct were breached; and the number of cases
18	from which the staff or any member of the Commission recused himself due to an actual or possible
19	conflict. The report shall also include (a) the name of any judge who the Commission concluded breached
20	the Canons of Judicial Conduct and took disciplinary action against as a result of such conclusion and the
21	date on which the Commission reached such conclusion after the previous annual report was published,
22	(b) the specific Canons of Judicial Conduct breached by such judge, and (c) the disciplinary action taken
23	against such judge by the Commission.
24	2. That on or before December 1, 2023, the Judicial Inquiry and Review Commission (the
25	Commission) shall publish in its annual report (i) the name of any judge who the Commission

26 concluded breached the Canons of Judicial Conduct on or after January 1, 2016, and took

- 27 disciplinary action against as a result of such conclusion; (ii) the specific Canons of Judicial Conduct
- 28 breached by such judge; and (iii) the disciplinary action taken against such judge by the29 Commission.

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
