6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 15.2-955 of the Code of Virginia, relating to emergency medical services
7	agencies; ordinances or resolutions; designation as emergency response agencies.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 15.2-955 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 15.2-955. Approval by local governing body for the establishment of volunteer emergency
11	medical services agencies and firefighting organizations.
12	A. No volunteer emergency medical services agency or volunteer firefighting organization shall
13	be established in any locality on or after July 1, 1984, without the prior approval by ordinance or resolution
14	of the governing body. Such ordinance or resolution shall specify the geographic boundaries of the
15	agency's primary service area within the locality.
16	B. Each locality shall seek to ensure that essential emergency medical services are maintained
17	throughout the entire locality.
18	C. An emergency medical services agency that responds to medical emergencies for its primary
19	service area as defined by the local emergency medical response plan shall be a designated emergency
20	response agency and recognized as an integral and essential part of the official public safety program of
21	the county, city, or town with responsibility for providing emergency medical response.
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
