6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 36-22.2, relating to housing
7	authorities; common household pets.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 36-22.2 as follows:
10	§ 36-22.2. Common household pets.
11	A. For purposes of this section, "reasonable condition" means rules or policies including but not
12	limited to those governing health, sanitation, nuisance, threat, leashing requirements, requirements to carry
13	liability insurance coverage, pet deposits, spaying and neutering requirements, prohibitions on pets kept
14	for the purpose of training for fighting or wagering of bets, weight limits on pets over 50 pounds, and
15	prohibitions on types of dogs classified as dangerous pursuant to § 3.2-6540 or 3.2-6540.1. "Reasonable
16	condition" does not include a prohibition on a particular breed of dog or cat.
17	B. Each housing authority shall permit a tenant to own or maintain one or more dogs or cats within
18	the tenant's dwelling unit, subject to applicable state and federal law and regulations regarding public
19	health or safety, animal control, and animal cruelty and other reasonable conditions.
