6	A BILL to direct the Department of Labor and Industry to study increasing tipped employee wages and
7	address wage theft by employers of tipped employees.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The Department of Labor and Industry shall convene a work group to study (i) increasing tipped
10	employee minimum cash wages incrementally until the minimum cash wage for tipped employees
11	matches the minimum wage prescribed by § 40.1-28.10; (ii) circumstances related to wage theft or
12	payment inequities by employers of tipped employees and recommendations related to mitigating such
13	wage theft or payment inequities; and (iii) amending the penalty provisions of §§ 40.1-28.11 and 40.1-
14	28.12 as they apply to employee remedies and employer penalties for violations of minimum wage
15	requirements. The work group shall include representation from tipped employee labor organizations,
16	legal aid organizations that represent tipped employees, tipped employee advocacy groups, employers of
17	tipped employees, and advocacy groups for employers of tipped employees. As used in this act, "tipped
18	employee" has the same meaning as provided in § 40.1-28.9.
