6	A BILL to direct the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to convene a work group relating
7	to blue catfish; report.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (the Department) shall, in order to
10	support and encourage coordination regarding efforts to create a robust and resilient market for blue
11	catfish, convene a work group of stakeholders that have a vested interest in reducing the negative
12	ecological effects of blue catfish and increasing the marketing, processing, and sale of blue catfish in the
13	Commonwealth. The work group shall include representatives of the following: the Marine Resources
14	Commission, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Education, the James River Association,
15	the Virginia Seafood Agricultural Research and Extension Center, the Marine Products Board, the
16	Virginia Institute of Marine Science, the Virginia Waterman's Association, the Virginia Restaurant,
17	Lodging & Travel Association, current and prospective blue catfish processors, Friends of the
18	Rappahannock, the Chesapeake Bay Foundation, and other state agencies or stakeholders deemed
19	necessary by the Department. The work group shall (i) review past and ongoing efforts to promote the
20	creation of a market for blue catfish, (ii) identify and explore potential sectors for the blue catfish market,
21	and (iii) identify any actions that the Commonwealth can take to promote and expand the market for blue
22	catfish. The Department shall submit a report of the findings and recommendations of the work group to
23	the Governor, the Secretary of Agriculture and Forestry, the Secretary of Natural and Historic Resources,
24	and the Chairs of the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources, the Senate
25	Committee on Finance and Appropriations, the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural
26	Resources, and the House Committee on Appropriations no later than September 1, 2025.
