9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That §§ 22.1-175.1 and 22.1-175.4 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 22.1-175.1. Virginia Public School Construction Grants Program established.
12	A. For the purposes of this chapter:
13	"Public school buildings and facilities" or "public school buildings" includes any building or
14	facility used for career and technical education programs provided at any regional comprehensive school
15	established pursuant to § 22.1-26.
16	"School division" includes joint or regional schools established pursuant to § 22.1-26.
17	B. The Virginia Public School Construction Grants Program is hereby established to provide grants
18	to eligible school divisions for school construction, additions, infrastructure, site acquisition for public
19	school buildings and facilities, and renovations, including the costs of retrofitting or enlarging public
20	school buildings; further, if a school division has completed any such projects during the previous-ten 10
21	years, the grants may be used for debt service payments or a portion thereof. The Program shall be
22	administered by the Board of Education.
23	Local governing bodies may also establish a separate escrow fund for the deposit of such funds as
24	provided in § 22.1-175.5.
25	§ 22.1-175.4. Application for grants.

All funds appropriated for financial assistance for the purposes of this chapter shall be apportioned	
and distributed among the school divisions of the Commonwealth in accordance with eligibility and needs	
criteria established by the 2000 Session of the General Assembly Board.	
2. That the Board of Education shall update the guidelines it is required to issue pursuant to $\S$ 22.1-	
175.3 of the Code of Virginia to explicitly clarify that grants provided to any qualifying school	
division under the Virginia Public School Construction Grants Program may be used for	
construction, additions, infrastructure, site acquisition, and renovations for buildings and facilities.
