12	§ 19.2-271.7. Prohibiting inquiry into the immigration status of defendant; notification of
13	consequences.
14	Prior to the start of proceedings, the court shall advise any defendant that immigration
15	consequences, including possible detention, incarceration, or deportation connected to an immigration
16	action, are possible if such defendant is convicted of a criminal violation of state or local law. No court or
17	party shall inquire as to the immigration status of the defendant during any proceeding unless otherwise
18	admissible.
