6	A BILL to direct the Commission on Electric Utility Regulation to evaluate the design and deployment of
7	the electrical distribution infrastructure necessary to support the installation of electric vehicle
8	charging facilities in certain residential developments.
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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That the Commission on Electric Utility Regulation (the Commission) shall evaluate the design
11	and deployment of the electrical distribution infrastructure necessary to support the installation of electric
12	vehicle charging facilities in new developments consisting of single-family and multifamily residential
13	units. Such evaluation shall include an assessment of (i) any design standards and requirements utilized
14	by investor-owned utilities in the planning, construction, or installation of electrical distribution
15	infrastructure for such developments; (ii) requirements and standards for the siting and placement of
16	electric vehicle charging infrastructure within such developments; and (iii) potential modifications to
17	electrical distribution infrastructure design standards and requirements to minimize impact on planned
18	density and layout of any new residential or multifamily development. In conducting its evaluation, the
19	Commission shall engage representatives from the residential and commercial development industries,
20	private sector utility consultants, and other stakeholders as determined by the Commission.
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
