6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 54.1-2313.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Cemetery Board;
7	appointment of receiver upon revocation or surrender of license to operate cemetery in Virginia.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 54.1-2313.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 54.1-2313.1. Protection of preneed burial and perpetual care trust funds; operation of
11	cemetery company; appointment of receiver.
12	No licensee or any agent of the licensee shall divert or misuse any funds held in trust or otherwise
13	held by him for another. If preneed or perpetual care funds are held in trust and the Board or its agents
14	have reason to believe that (i) the licensee is not able to adequately protect the interest of the person
15	involved; (ii) the licensee has had his license suspended, revoked, or surrendered; or surrend
16	of the licensee or the operation of the cemetery threatens the interests of the public, the Board-may shall
17	file a petition with any court of record having equity jurisdiction over the licensee or any of the funds held
18	by him stating the facts upon which it relies and the relief requested.
19	The court may temporarily enjoin further activity by the licensee and take such further action as
20	shall be necessary to ensure that the cemetery company is operated in full compliance with this chapter
21	and the Board's regulations, or to conserve, protect, and disburse the funds involved, or both, including
22	the appointment of a receiver to operate. If a receiver is appointed, the expenses of such receivership and
23	a reasonable fee, as determined by the court, shall be paid from the assets of the cemetery company. The
24	Board shall not be liable for any expenses or fees of the receiver.
