HOUSE BILL NO. 67

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Transportation

on _____)

(Patron Prior to Substitute--Delegate Edmunds)

A BILL to amend and reenact § 46.2-1121 of the Code of Virginia, relating to projecting vehicle loads; flagging.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-1121 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-1121. Flag or light at end of load.

Whenever the load on any vehicle extends more than four feet beyond the rear of the bed or body thereof, there shall be displayed at the end of the load, in such a position as to be clearly visible at all times from the rear of the load, a ~~red~~ fluorescent orange, green, or yellow flag, not less than ~~twelve~~ 18 inches, both in length and width. Between sunset and sunrise, however, there shall be displayed at the end of the load a red light plainly visible in clear weather at least 500 feet to the sides and rear of the vehicle.

2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 2023.
