

SENATE BILL NO. 510

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on General Laws and Technology

on _____)

(Patron Prior to Substitute--Senator Suetterlein)

A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 54.1-2105.1 and 54.1-2109 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; Real Estate Board; death or disability of a real estate broker.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 54.1-2105.1 and 54.1-2109 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 54.1-2105.1. Other powers and duties of the Real Estate Board.

In addition to the provisions of §§ 54.1-2105.01 through 54.1-2105.04, the Board shall:

1. Develop a residential property disclosure statement form for use in accordance with the provisions of the Virginia Residential Property Disclosure Act (§ 55.1-700 et seq.) and maintain such statement on its website. The Board shall also develop and maintain on its website a one-page form to be signed by the parties acknowledging that the purchaser has been advised of the disclosures listed in the residential property disclosure statement located on the Board's website; and

2. Inform licensed brokers, in a manner deemed appropriate by the Board, of the broker's ~~ability requirement, pursuant to § 54.1-2109,~~ to designate another licensed broker to carry on the business for up to 180 days for the sole purpose of concluding the business of such designating broker in the event of the designating broker's death or disability.

§ 54.1-2109. Death or disability of a real estate broker.

~~Upon the death or disability of a licensed real estate broker who was~~ A. Any licensed broker who is engaged in a sole proprietorship or who is the only licensed broker in a business entity listed in clause (i) of subsection A of § 54.1-2106.1 shall designate another licensed broker to carry on the business for up to 180 days for the sole purpose of concluding the business of such designating broker in the event

27 of the designating broker's death or disability. Such designation shall be made at the time of application
28 for broker licensure.

29 B. Only in the event that the designated broker named pursuant to subsection A is unable or
30 unwilling to perform the act of concluding the business, the Real Estate Board shall, within 30 days of
31 receiving written notification of a broker's death or disability, grant approval to one of the following
32 individuals to carry on the business of the deceased or disabled broker for up to 180 days following the
33 death or disability of the broker solely for the sole purpose of concluding the business of the deceased or
34 disabled broker in the following order:

35 1. A personal representative qualified by the court to administer the deceased broker's estate.;

36 2. ~~If there is no personal representative qualified pursuant to subdivision 1, then an~~ An agent
37 designated under a power of attorney of the ~~disabled or deceased~~ or disabled broker, which designation
38 expressly references this section.;

39 3. ~~If there is no agent designated pursuant to subdivision 2, the~~ The executor nominated in the
40 deceased broker's will.;

41 4. ~~If there is no executor nominated pursuant to subdivision 3, then an~~ An adult family member of
42 the ~~disabled or deceased~~ or disabled broker.;

43 5. ~~If there is no adult family member nominated pursuant to subdivision 4, then an~~ An employee
44 of, or an independent contractor affiliated with, the ~~disabled or deceased~~ or disabled broker.

45 C. In the event that none of the foregoing is individuals in subsection B 1 through 5 are available
46 or suitable, the Board may appoint any other suitable person to terminate licensed broker, with the written
47 consent of such broker, within 30 days of receiving written notification of a broker's death or disability,
48 to allow such appointed broker to carry on the business of the deceased or disabled broker for the sole
49 purpose of concluding the business within 180 days.

50 **2. That the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation shall amend the broker**
51 **renewal license application form to require applicants for a renewal real estate broker license to**
52 **state there has been no change to the licensed broker designated pursuant to subsection A of § 54.1-**
53 **2109.**

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
