6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 62.1-44.4 of the Code of Virginia, relating to water quality; economic and
7	social development.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 62.1-44.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 62.1-44.4. Control by Commonwealth as to water quality.
11	(1) A. No right to continue existing quality degradation in any state water shall exist nor shall such
12	right be or be deemed to have been acquired by virtue of past or future discharge of sewage, industrial
13	wastes or other wastes or other action by any owner. The right and control of the Commonwealth in and
14	over all state waters is hereby expressly reserved and reaffirmed.
15	(2) B. Waters whose existing quality is better than the established standards as of the date on which
16	such standards become effective will be maintained at high quality; provided that the Board has the power
17	to authorize any project or development, which that would constitute a new or an increased discharge of
18	effluent to high quality water, when it has been affirmatively demonstrated that a change is justifiable to
19	provide necessary economic or social development; and provided, further, that the necessary degree of
20	waste treatment to maintain high water quality will be required where physically and economically
21	feasible. If the Board authorizes a project or development that would constitute a discharge of effluent to
22	high quality water, it shall ensure that such discharge does not have a disproportionate adverse impact on
23	historically economically or socially disadvantaged communities. Present and anticipated use of such
24	waters will be preserved and protected.
