6	A BILL to direct the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services to establish a work
7	group to study and make recommendations regarding the cases in which the Office of the Chief
8	Medical Examiner shall conduct an investigation of the death of a person who dies while receiving
9	services from a program licensed by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental
10	Services.
11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. § 1. The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (the Department) shall establish
13	a work group, which shall include the Commissioner of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services,
14	the Director of the Department of Criminal Justice Services, the Commissioner of Social Services, the
15	State Registrar of Vital Records, and the Chief Medical Examiner, or their designees, and representatives
16	of the disAbility Law Center of Virginia, the Virginia Hospital and Healthcare Association, the Virginia
17	Association of Community Services Boards, providers of behavioral health services licensed by the
18	Department, law-enforcement agencies, emergency medical services providers, community stakeholders
19	such as social workers, community mental health providers, and case managers, and other appropriate
20	agency staff and other stakeholders, to study and make recommendations regarding appropriate
21	investigations, including recommendations regarding when autopsies may be appropriate, of the deaths of
22	individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities who are residents of the Commonwealth and
23	who die while receiving services from a program licensed by the Department. The work group shall report
24	its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the Chairmen of the House Committee on Health,
25	Welfare and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Education and Health by November 1, 2022.
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
