6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 23.1-2911.3, relating to
7	Standardized Health Care Academy Program; established.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 23.1-2911.3 as follows:
10	§ 23.1-2911.3. Standardized Health Care Academy Program.
11	A. The State Board shall establish the Standardized Health Care Academy Program (the Program)
12	for the purpose of providing training and opportunities to high school students in health care professional
13	programs that are offered by two-year associate-degree-granting public institutions of higher education.
14	B. A student that meets the definition of "eligible student" pursuant to the Get Skilled, Get a Job,
15	Give Back Program (G3 Program) established in § 23.1-2911.2 or pursuant to the New Economy
16	Workforce Credential Grant Program established in § 23.1-627.3 and meets the other requirements for the
17	G3 Program or the New Economy Workforce Credential Grant Program may receive funding from one
18	such program to cover his tuition. If a student does not meet the definition of "eligible student" for the G3
19	Program or the New Economy Workforce Credential Grant Program, funding provided pursuant to the
20	dual enrollment agreement between the school board and the associate-degree-granting public institution
21	of higher education may pay for such student's tuition. The school shall also provide transportation for
22	students to and from the associate-degree-granting institutions at which such students take courses.
23	C. The State Board shall work with the Department of Education to (i) map pathways for students
24	beginning in the sixth grade to ensure that such students are academically prepared to enter the Program
25	as juniors in high school; (ii) determine eligibility criteria for students desiring to enroll in the Program;
26	(iii) determine how course credits that students receive from the associate-degree-granting institution shall
