| 13 | enforcement agency who specifically is authorized to make a request for towing by the chief law- |
| 14 | enforcement officer or his designee for the towing and recovery of a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight |
| 15 | rating of greater than 26,000 pounds, the towing and recovery operator shall include the telephone number |
| 16 | and website address for the Division of Consumer Counsel within the Office of the Attorney General. |
| 17 | Any towing and recovery operator in violation of the provisions of this section shall be subject to |
| 18 | a civil penalty of \$1,000 per violation. |
