| 11 | A. When driving a truck or truck and trailer or semitrailer combination during active snow, sleet, |
| 12 | freezing rain, or other cold inclement precipitation, the operator: |
| 13 | 1. Shall, if reasonably possible and conditions safely permit, drive the vehicle in the right-most |
| 14 | lane of any highway having two or more lanes in each direction; |
| 15 | 2. Shall not utilize cruise control; and |
| 16 | 3. Shall not utilize compression release engine brakes, commonly known as Jake brakes or Jacobs |
| 17 | Exhaust Brakes. |
| 18 | B. This section shall not apply to the operation of pickup trucks or panel trucks. |
