6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 9.1-906.1, relating to sex offenders
7	in emergency shelters; notification; registration.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 9.1-906.1 as follows:
10	§ 9.1-906.1. Emergency shelters; notification; registration.
11	Any person required to register or reregister who enters any place or facility that is designated by
12	the Commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof as an emergency shelter and operated in response
13	to a state or local emergency declared pursuant to Chapter 3.2 (§ 44-146.13 et seq.) of Title 44 shall, as
14	soon as practicable after entry, notify a member of the emergency shelter's staff who is responsible for
15	providing security at the emergency shelter that such person is a registered sex offender. The use of such
16	Registry information pursuant to this section does not constitute a violation of § 9.1-918. No person shall
17	be denied entry into an emergency shelter solely on the basis of his status as a registered sex offender
18	unless such entry is otherwise prohibited by law.
19	2. That the Department of State Police shall provide to any person required to register on the Sex
20	Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry at the time of his initial registration a summary of
21	the provisions of this act.
