6	A BILL to require the Board of Education, in conjunction with the Secretary of Education and the
7	Superintendent of Public Instruction, to convene a group of stakeholders to evaluate certain current
8	and proposed policies and performance standards for public elementary and secondary schools and
9	students and report recommendations for revising these policies and standards to promote
10	excellence and higher student achievement.
11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. § 1. The Board of Education (the Board) shall collaborate with the Superintendent of Public Instruction
13	and the Secretary of Education to convene a group of stakeholders to include parents, public school
14	principals, public school superintendents, public school board members, institutions of higher education,
15	the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia, industry partners and employers, and other concerned
16	stakeholders to evaluate, to implement where possible, and to otherwise make recommendations to the
17	General Assembly regarding the following goals:
18	1. Promoting excellence in instruction and student achievement in mathematics;
19	2. Expanding the Advanced Studies Diploma as an option for students in public high schools in
20	the Commonwealth;
21	3. Increasing the transparency of performance measures for public elementary and secondary
22	schools in the Commonwealth;
23	4. Ensuring that performance measures for public elementary and secondary schools prioritize the
24	attainment of grade-level proficiency and growth during the course of a school year and from school year
25	to school year in reading and mathematics for all students, especially in grades kindergarten through five;

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<b>26</b>	5. Ensuring that the Commonwealth's proficiency standards on Standards of Learning assessments
27	in reading and mathematics are maintained; and
28	6. Ensuring a strong accreditation system that promotes meaningful accountability year-over-year
29	§ 2. No later than November 30, 2022, the Secretary of Education and the Superintendent of Public
30	Instruction shall report to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee
31	on Education and Health the results of the evaluation conducted pursuant to § 1 of this act and
32	recommendations to achieve the goals set forth in § 1 of this act.
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
