6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-311.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to removing serial number
7	on firearm; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-311.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-311.1. Removing serial number on firearm.
11	Any It is unlawful for any person, firm, association, or corporation who or which to intentionally
12	removes, defaces, alters, changes, destroys or obliterates in any manner or way remove, change, destroy,
13	or obliterate or who or which causes cause to be removed, defaced, altered, changed, destroyed, or
14	obliterated in any manner or way the name of the maker, model, manufacturer's or a serial number, or any
15	other mark or identification required by federal law on any pistol, shotgun, rifle, machine gun, or any other
16	firearm-shall be guilty of. A violation of this subsection is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
17	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
18	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary
19	appropriation is for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities;
20	therefore, Chapter 552 of the Acts of Assembly of 2021, Special Session I, requires the Virginia
21	Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-
22	19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is for
23	periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
