9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. The Virginia Department of Health Professions shall convene a workgroup consisting of
11	representatives of the Virginia Dental Association, the Virginia Dental Hygienists' Association, the
12	Association of Dental Support Organizations, the Virginia Board of Dentistry, and other relevant
13	stakeholders to analyze licensure requirements for dentists and dental hygienists in the Commonwealth
14	and determine what changes to such requirements may be warranted, if any, to ensure access to affordable,
15	quality dental care throughout the Commonwealth. The workgroup shall (i) compare licensure
16	requirements for dentists and dental hygienists in the Commonwealth with such requirements in other
17	states and the District of Columbia; (ii) analyze the number of licensed dentists in the Commonwealth
18	relative to population growth and geography; (iii) identify the risks and benefits to the public if a licensure
19	by endorsement pathway were to exist in the Commonwealth; and (iv) identify any other licensure
20	pathways that would serve the public good. The workgroup shall report its findings along with any
21	recommendations for legislation to the House Committee on Health, Welfare, and Institutions and the
22	Senate Committee on Education and Health by October 1, 2023.
