5	(Patron Prior to SubstituteSenator Barker)
6	A BILL to provide for the operation of the local health department of the City of Alexandria.
7	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
8	1. § 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the local governing body of the City
9	of Alexandria (the City) may enter into a contract with the State Board of Health (the Board) to provide
10	local health services in the City. If the local governing body enters into a contract with the Board pursuant
11	to this act, the local governing body shall not eliminate any service required by law or reduce the level of
12	service below that required by law. In addition, the local governing body shall not eliminate or reduce the
13	level of any service currently delivered in connection with the Commonwealth's program of medical
14	assistance.
15	Any contract executed between the local governing body and the Board shall set forth the rights
16	and responsibilities of the local governing body for the delivery of health services and shall require that
17	the local director of health services be appointed by the City in accordance with local procedures, with the
18	concurrence of the State Health Commissioner. The local health director of health services shall be
19	employed full time as an employee of the City and shall be responsible for directing all state-mandated
20	public health programs. All employees of the local health department operated by the City shall be
21	employees of the City.
22	The City shall operate the local health department, pursuant to the terms of the contract, with such
23	local appropriations and any state funds as may be made available to it, pursuant to the general
24	appropriation act. State funds for the operation of health services and facilities shall continue to be
25	allocated to the City as if such services were provided in the City without such a contract.

26	The City shall maintain and submit such financial and statistical records as may be required by the
27	Board.
28	Upon entering into a contract with the Board pursuant to this act, the City shall be the sole owner
29	of all equipment and supplies, including all equipment and supplies used by the local health department
30	at the time of execution of the contract, that were or are purchased for providing public health services
31	regardless of the source of the funds for such purchases.
32	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person who is transferred from
33	state to local employment in accordance with a contract authorized by this act, and who is a member of
34	the Virginia Retirement System at the time of the transfer, shall continue to be a member of the Virginia
35	Retirement System during the period of local employment.
36	The power to contract conferred by this act shall not be deemed to confer any additional authority
37	to impose fees for local health services upon the City.
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
