12	A. Any person who possesses a firearm in a residence where such person knows that a minor under
13	18 years of age or a person who is prohibited by law from possessing a firearm resides shall store such
14	firearm and the ammunition for such firearm in a locked container, compartment, or cabinet that is
15	inaccessible to such minor or prohibited person. Any person who violates this section is guilty of a Class
16	4 misdemeanor.
17	B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to (i) any person in lawful possession of a firearm
18	who carries such firearm on or about his person or (ii) the storage of any antique firearm as defined in §
19	<u>18.2-308.2:2.</u>
20	C. Nothing in this section shall be construed as preventing any person from lawfully authorizing a
21	minor to access a firearm in accordance with § 18.2-56.2.
22	D. Every dealer, as defined in § 18.2-308.2:2, shall post in a conspicuous manner at the premises
23	of such dealer a notice stating "Any person who possesses a firearm in a residence where such person
24	knows that a minor under 18 years of age or a person who is prohibited by law from possessing a firearm
25	resides shall store such firearm and the ammunition for such firearm in a locked container, compartment,
