10	If any A. Any person who (i) without authority of law goes upon or remains upon the lands,
11	buildings, or premises of another, or any portion or area thereof, (a) after having been forbidden to do so,
12	either orally or in writing, by the owner, lessee, or custodian, or the agent of any such person, or other
13	person lawfully in charge thereof, or (b) after having been forbidden to do so by a sign or signs posted by
14	or at the direction of such persons or the agent of any such person or by the holder of any easement or
15	other right-of-way authorized by the instrument creating such interest to post such signs on such lands,
16	structures, premises, or portion or area thereof, at a place or places where it or they may be reasonably
17	seen, or if any person, (ii) whether he is the owner, the tenant, or otherwise entitled to the use of such the
18	land, building, or premises of another, or any portion or area thereof, goes upon, or remains upon such
19	land, building, or premises after having been prohibited from doing so by a court of competent jurisdiction
