6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 5 of Chapter 9 of Title 15.2 a section numbered
7	15.2-977.1, relating to local incentives for urban green space.
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8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 5 of Chapter 9 of Title 15.2 a section
10	numbered 15.2-977.1, as follows:
11	<u>§ 15.2-977.1. Local incentives for urban green space.</u>
12	A. For purposes of this section, "urban green space" means urban land, partly or completely
13	covered with grass, trees, shrubs, or other vegetation, that is located in a densely populated area that has
14	a high concentration of residential or commercial structures. "Urban green space" includes street trees,
15	city parks, sports fields, gardens, and greenways. To qualify as urban green space, the use of such land
16	must make a substantive impact on the reduction of the urban heat effect, the offsetting of greenhouse gas
17	emissions, or the mitigation of stormwater. Rural areas and areas of low population density or
18	development shall not be considered urban green space.
19	B. Any county, city, or town may, by ordinance, establish a program to provide regulatory
20	flexibility to encourage the preservation, restoration, or development of urban green space in the locality.
21	Any such regulatory flexibility provided shall be proportionate to the amount of urban green space that a
22	business or development contains.
23	C. The regulatory flexibility may include (i) a reduction in permit fees or (ii) a streamlined process
24	for the approval of permits.
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
