| 11 | A. The governing body of any county, city, or town may, by ordinance, regulate noise from a |
| 12 | vehicle operated on a highway that is not equipped with a muffler and exhaust system conforming to §§ |
| 13 | 46.2-1047 and 46.2-1049. Such ordinance may also authorize such regulation of a vehicle operated on |
| 14 | public or private property in or within 500 feet of any residential district, including (i) the premises of a |
| 15 | church, school, recreational facility, or business or government property open to the public; (ii) an |
| 16 | establishment providing parking spaces for customers, patrons, or employees; or (iii) any highway that is |
| 17 | either under construction or not yet open for public use. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to |
| 18 | authorize the governing body of any county, city, or town to prohibit or regulate exhaust system noise |
| 19 | from vehicles engaged in agricultural operations as defined in § 3.2-300 or any industrial or commercial |
| 20 | activities or operations on private property authorized by the owner of the private property. |
