8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-290.03 as follows:
10	<u>§ 22.1-290.03. Teacher Residency Trainings Corps Grant Fund and Program.</u>
11	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund to be known as the
12	Teacher Residency Trainings Corps Grant Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund shall
13	be established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds appropriated for such purpose and any gifts,
14	donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its behalf shall be paid into the state treasury and
15	credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it.
16	Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not
17	revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used solely for the
18	purposes of awarding grants on a competitive basis pursuant to the Teacher Residency Trainings Corps
19	Grant Program established in subsection B. Expenditures and disbursements from the Fund shall be made
20	by the State Treasurer on warrants issued by the Comptroller upon written request signed by the
21	Superintendent.
22	B. There is hereby established the Teacher Residency Trainings Corps Grant Program (the
23	Program), to be administered by the Department, for the purpose of awarding grants from the Fund on a
24	competitive basis to any public institution of higher education with an approved education preparation
25	program that establishes a teacher residency training corps scholarship program whereby the institution
26	and a student enrolled in the education preparation program enter into a contract pursuant to which the
