6	A BILL to require the Department of Medical Assistance Services to include in its contracts with managed
7	care organizations requirements for the collection and reporting of certain data; report.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Medical Assistance Services (the Department) shall collect and report (i)
10	the number and percentage of claims submitted to managed care organizations that were denied and the
11	reasons for such denials and (ii) the number and percentage of claims submitted to managed care
12	organizations that required resubmission prior to payment and the reasons for such resubmissions. Such
13	data shall be reported for each fiscal year from fiscal year 2018 through fiscal year 2022 and shall be
14	organized by major provider type, including primary care providers and urgent care centers. The
15	Department shall examine such data and identify barriers that providers encounter when accepting and
16	treating patients enrolled in the state plan for medical assistance services. The Department shall report
17	such data and analysis to the Joint Commission on Health Care and the Joint Subcommittee for Health
18	and Human Resources Oversight by November 1, 2023.
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
