8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 3.2-6594 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 3.2-6594. Definitions.
11	As used in this article:
12	"Dangerous captive animal" means any bear, cougar, elephant, jaguar, leopard, lion, nonhumar
13	primate, or tiger, or any hybrid of any such animal. "Dangerous captive animal" does not include a clouded
14	leopard.
15	"Direct contact" means physical contact or proximity where physical contact is possible, including
16	an opportunity for photography without a permanent physical barrier designed to prevent physical contact
17	between the public and a dangerous captive animal.
18	"Keeper" means any person, as defined in § 1-230, who owns, has custody of, or is in control of a
19	dangerous captive animal.
