12	signals within such school crossing zones. The work group shall include representatives of the
13	Department; Department of State Police; Virginia Association of Counties; Virginia Municipal League
14	Virginia Association of School Superintendents; Virginia School Boards Association; Virginia Parent
15	Teacher Association; local governing bodies where the Department is responsible for maintaining the
16	roads; and any other relevant stakeholders with expertise in pedestrian safety. The work group shall
