8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That §§ 16.1-69.48:6, 17.1-275.13, and 18.2-346.01 of the Code of Virginia are amended and
10	reenacted as follows:
11	§ 16.1-69.48:6. Fees for offenses related to sex trafficking.
12	The court shall order any person convicted of a-misdemeanor violation of § 18.2-346.01-or of §.
13	18.2-348, or 18.2-349 to pay a \$100 \$1,000 fee, which shall be deposited into the Virginia Prevention of
14	Sex Trafficking Fund to be used in accordance with § 9.1-116.4.
15	§ 17.1-275.13. Additional fee for offenses related to sex trafficking.
16	In addition to the fees provided for by §§ 17.1-275.1, 17.1-275.2, 17.1-275.7, 17.1-275.10, and
17	17.1-275.12, any person convicted of a misdemeanor violation of § 18.2-346.01 or of § 18.2-348, or 18.2-
18	349 shall be ordered to pay a \$100 \$1,000 fee, and any person convicted of a violation of clause (ii), (iii),
19	or (iv) of § 18.2-48, or of § 18.2-368, or any felony violation of the laws pertaining to commercial sex
20	trafficking or prostitution offenses pursuant to Article 3 (§ 18.2-346 et seq.) of Chapter 8, with the
21	exception of § 18.2-361, shall be ordered to pay a \$500 \$2,500 fee. All fees collected pursuant to this
22	section shall be deposited into the Virginia Prevention of Sex Trafficking Fund to be used in accordance
23	with § 9.1-116.4.
24	§ 18.2-346.01. Prostitution; solicitation; commercial exploitation of a minor; penalties.
25	A. Any person who offers money or its equivalent to another for the purpose of engaging in sexual
26	acts enumerated in § 18.2-346 and thereafter does any substantial act in furtherance thereof is guilty of

27	solicitation of prostitution, which is punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor, except as provided in
28	subsections B and C.
29	However, any B. Any person who solicits prostitution from a minor (i) 16 years of age or older is
30	guilty of a Class 6 felony or (ii) younger than 16 years of age is guilty of a Class 5 felony.
31	C. Any person who commits a third or subsequent offense under subsection A is guilty of a Class
32	<u>6 felony.</u>
33	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
34	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary
35	appropriation is for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities;
36	therefore, Chapter 2 of the Acts of Assembly of 2022, Special Session I, requires the Virginia
37	Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-
38	19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is for
39	periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
