6	A BILL to direct the Department of Education to develop and promulgate regulations to enforce a code
7	of ethics for Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings relating to appropriate participation
8	and collaboration.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That the Department of Education (the Department), in consultation with the disAbility Law Center
11	of Virginia, the Parent Educational Advocacy Training Center, and other stakeholders, shall develop a
12	code of ethics relating to appropriate collaboration at Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings
13	among school staff, parents, students, and any other participants invited with expertise or knowledge of
14	the student, to be referred to as the Code of Ethics for Special Education Meeting Participants (the Code
15	of Ethics). The Code of Ethics shall be consistent with the Council of Parent Attorneys and Advocates
16	Voluntary Code of Ethics and the Superintendent of Public Instruction's Memo # 263-16 (October 18,
17	2016): Collaboration among Parents, Parent Advocates, and Professionals in IEP Meetings and shall
18	include provisions affirming the rights of parents to collaborate and participate in the IEP process. The
19	Department shall amend such regulations as may be necessary to effectuate the provisions of this act.
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
