

SENATE BILL NO. 1509

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Commerce and Labor
on January 30, 2023)

(Patron Prior to Substitute--Senator Mason)

A BILL to amend and reenact § 59.1-21.2 of the Code of Virginia, relating to home solicitation sale;
definition.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 59.1-21.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 59.1-21.2. Definitions.

A. ~~Home~~ As used in this chapter, "home solicitation sale" means:

1. A consumer sale or lease of goods or services in which the seller or a person acting for him
engages (i) in a personal solicitation of the sale or lease or (ii) in a solicitation of the sale or lease by
~~telephonic telephone or other~~ electronic means at any residence other than that of the seller without prior
invitation or appointment; and

2. The buyer's agreement or offer to purchase or lease is there given to the seller or a person acting
for him.

B. As used in this chapter:

1. "Home solicitation sale" ~~shall~~ does not mean a consumer sale or lease of farm equipment or a
consumer sale made by an entity regulated by the State Corporation Commission's Bureau of Insurance,
an affiliate of any such entity, or a dealer licensed by the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board.

2. ~~It~~ "Home solicitation sale" does not include cash sales of less than ~~twenty-five dollars~~ \$25, a
sale or lease made pursuant to a preexisting revolving charge account, or a sale or lease made pursuant to
prior negotiations between the parties.
