6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 30-405 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Behavioral Health
7	Commission; powers and duties; process to solicit and receive input.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 30-405 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 30-405. (For contingent expiration date, see Acts 2021, Sp. Sess. I, c. 313, cl. 2) Powers and
11	duties of the Commission; report.
12	The Commission shall have the following powers and duties:
13	1. To collect and analyze information and data necessary to accomplish the purpose set forth in §
14	30-402;
15	2. To monitor and evaluate the jurisdiction, powers and duties, operations, management, and
16	interrelationships of any department, division, board, bureau, commission, authority, or other agency with
17	direct responsibility for the delivery, coordination, management, or financing of behavioral health services
18	in the Commonwealth and develop recommendations for the improvement thereof;
19	3. To monitor and evaluate the design, implementation, and operation of new behavioral health
20	initiatives in the Commonwealth and develop recommendations for the improvement thereof;
21	4. To examine matters related to the delivery of behavioral health services in other states and to
22	consult and exchange information with officers and agencies of other states with respect to behavioral
23	health service issues of mutual concern;
24	5. To maintain offices and hold meetings and functions at any place in the Commonwealth that it
25	deems necessary;
26	6. To invite other interested parties to sit with the Commission and participate in its deliberations;

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27	7. To appoint any work group or special task force from among its members to study and make
28	recommendations on specific matters before the Commission; and
29	8. To implement a process to solicit and receive input from (i) individuals who are currently
30	receiving or have received behavioral health services or (ii) individuals with intellectual or developmental
31	disabilities or autism spectrum disorders or the family members of such individuals to inform the work of
32	the Commission; and
33	9. To report its recommendations to the General Assembly and the Governor annually and to make
34	such interim reports as it deems advisable or as may be required by the General Assembly and the
35	Governor.

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
