6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 1-216.1, relating to hate crimes and
7	discrimination; persons of the Jewish faith or ethnicity; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 1-216.1 as follows:
10	§ 1-216.1. Hate crimes and discrimination; persons of the Jewish faith or ethnicity.
11	As used in §§ 2.2-3900 and 2.2-3902, "race," "religion," or "national origin" shall include persons
12	of the Jewish faith or ethnicity. As used in § 8.01-42.1, "racial animosity," "religious animosity," or "ethnic
13	animosity" shall include animosity toward the Jewish faith or ethnicity. As used in §§ 8.01-49.1, 18.2-57,
14	and 18.2-121, "race," "religious conviction," or "national origin" shall include persons of the Jewish faith
15	or ethnicity. As used in § 52-8.5, "race," "religion," or "ethnic or national origin" shall include persons of
16	the Jewish faith or ethnicity.
17	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
18	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary
19	appropriation is for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities;
20	therefore, Chapter 2 of the Acts of Assembly of 2022, Special Session I, requires the Virginia
21	Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-
22	19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is for
23	periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
