6	A BILL to direct the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia to convene a work group to make
7	recommendations on and develop a plan for expanding the Get Skilled, Get a Job, Get Ahead
8	Program.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (the Council) shall convene a work group
11	consisting of the Director of the Council or his designee, the Director of the Virginia Office of Education
12	Economics, the Director of Transfer of the Virginia Community College System (the System), the
13	Chancellor of the System, the Deputy Secretary of Higher Education, the Deputy Secretary of Labor, the
14	Chair of the Virginia Board of Workforce Development, three presidents of community colleges in the
15	Commonwealth or their designees, three presidents of baccalaureate public institutions of higher education
16	in the Commonwealth or their designees, and the Chairs of the House Committee on Education, the Senate
17	Committee on Education and Health, the Senate Subcommittee on Higher Education, and the House
18	Subcommittee on Higher Education, for the purpose of making recommendations on and developing a
19	plan for expanding the Get Skilled, Get a Job, Get Ahead (G3) Program. The work group shall elect one
20	of its members to serve as the chair of the work group. The work group shall also include staff of the
21	House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations. In
22	making its recommendations and developing its plan, the work group shall (i) coordinate its
23	recommendations with any recommendations made by the Office of Education and Labor Market
24	Alignment within the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority System pursuant to
25	paragraph D 2 of Item 213 of Chapter 2 of the Acts of Assembly of 2022, Special Session I; (ii) develop
26	the process and metrics by which curricular degree programs are selected for the G3 program; (iii) identify

transfer degree programs for the G3 Program that are best aligned with the workforce needs of the Commonwealth; (iv) identify any additional one-year and two-year degree programs for the G3 Program that are best aligned with the workforce needs of the Commonwealth; and (v) develop a plan for the implementation of the expanded G3 Program. The work group shall submit a report on its recommendations and plan for the expansion of the G3 Program to the Chairs of the House Committee on Education and Health by October 1, 2024.

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
