9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 37 of Title 54.1 an article numbered
11	3, consisting of sections numbered 54.1-3709.4 through 54.1-3709.8, as follows:
12	Article 3.
13	Social Work Advisory Board.
14	§ 54.1-3709.4. Social Work Advisory Board established; purpose.
15	The Social Work Advisory Board (the Advisory Board) is established as an advisory board in the
16	executive branch of state government. The purpose of the Advisory Board is to advise the Governor on
17	efforts to improve the social work profession in the Commonwealth.
18	§ 54.1-3709.5. Membership; terms; quorum; meetings.
19	The Advisory Board shall have a total membership of 20 members that shall consist of 15
20	nonlegislative citizen members and five ex officio members. Nonlegislative citizen members shall be
21	appointed by the Governor for a term of four years, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, and
22	shall include three social workers specializing in policy and planning; two community, administrative,
23	and research social workers; two medical or geriatric social workers; two social workers specializing in
24	mental health and substance use; two child and family social workers; a military social worker; a justice
25	and corrections social worker; a school social worker; and a social work educator working in a higher
26	education setting. Nonlegislative citizen members shall have a bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree in

social work from a college or university social work program accredited by the Council on Social Wo	<u>ork</u>
Education. Nonlegislative citizen members shall be citizens of the Commonwealth and shall be a members	<u>ber</u>
of at least one of the following organizations: the Council on Social Work Education, the Latino Social	<u>ial</u>
Workers Organization, the National Association of Social Workers, the National Association of Bla	<u>ack</u>

Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. All members may	be
reappointed.	
No nonlegislative citizen member shall serve more than two consecutive four-year terms. T	<u> he</u>
remainder of any term to which a member is appointed to fill a vacancy shall not constitute a term	in
determining the member's eligibility for reappointment.	
The Advisory Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership.	<u>. A</u>
majority of the members shall constitute a quorum. The meetings of the Advisory Board shall be held	l at
the call of the chairman or whenever the majority of the members so request.

Members shall receive such compensation for the performance of their duties as provided in § 2	<u>2-</u>
2813. All members shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in	<u>the</u>
performance of their duties as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825.

The Social Work Advisory Board shall have the power and duty to:

54	and enhancement of social safety net programs.
55	2. Sponsor events and educational media outreach and programs, conduct studies and research
56	prepare reports, and present recommendations to the Governor regarding social issues and social safety
57	net programs and issues important to social workers and clients.
58	3. Submit an annual report by December 1 to the Governor and the General Assembly for
59	publication as a report document as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated
60	Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports. The chairman of the Advisory Board
61	shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an annual executive summary of the interim
62	activity and work of the Advisory Board no later than the first day of each regular session of the General
63	Assembly. The executive summary shall be submitted for publication as a report document as provided in
64	the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative
65	documents and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.
