8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Housing and Community Development (the Department) shall convene an
10	advisory panel to develop and make available to each local governing body a model local ordinance for
11	the administration of accessory dwelling units.
12	The advisory panel shall consider, but not be limited to:
13	1. The definition of an accessory dwelling unit;
14	2. Owner occupancy requirements;
15	3. Parking requirements;
16	4. Minimum lot sizes;
17	5. Setbacks;
18	<u>6. Impact fees;</u>
19	7. Size and height restrictions; and
20	8. Potential conflicts with historic preservation rules, deed restrictions, or property owners'
21	association rules.
22	The advisory panel shall include representatives of local government, regional planning district
23	commissions, the residential land development and construction industry, environmental and conservation
24	organizations, nonprofit affordable housing organizations, and other stakeholders as determined by the
25	Department. The Department shall complete its work and publish the model ordinance on its website no
26	later than July 1, 2024.

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
