AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Patron Prior to Substitute--Senator Norment)

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 1 of Title 30 a section numbered 30-19.10.1 and to repeal Chapter 28 (§§ 30-193, 30-194, and 30-195) of Title 30 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Joint Committee on Rules; review and approval of plans for changes to artifacts contained within the Capitol Building; Capitol Square Preservation Council; repeal.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 1 of Title 30 a section numbered 30-19.10.1 as follows:

§ 30-19.10.1. Changes to historical artifacts contained within the Capitol Building.

The Joint Committee on Rules shall review all plans or proposals for alterations, improvements, additions, or renovations to, or other disposition of, any monuments, statuary, artwork, or other historical artifacts contained within the Capitol Building, including within the old and new Senate chambers, the old and new halls of the House of Delegates, and the Rotunda. No such plan or proposal shall be implemented unless a majority of Senate members and a majority of House members of the Joint Committee on Rules vote to approve the plan or proposal.

2. That Chapter 28 (§§ 30-193, 30-194, and 30-195) of Title 30 of the Code of Virginia is repealed.
