13	Any requirement in the general appropriation act that (i) the tuition and mandatory educational
4	and general fee rates for undergraduate non-Virginia students at each public institution of higher education
5	cover at least 100 percent of the average cost of the education of such students, as calculated through base
6	adequacy guidelines adopted and periodically amended by the Joint Subcommittee Studying Higher
7	Education Funding Policies or (ii) the total revenue generated by the collection of tuition and fees from
8	all students at each such institution is within the nongeneral fund appropriation for educational and general
9	programs provided in the general appropriation act is waived in relation to any non-Virginia undergraduate
0	student who has completed 30 credit hours of coursework and who is enrolled in a data science and
1	technology, science and engineering, health care, or education program at Norfolk State University,
2	Virginia State University, or any public institution of higher education at which the proportion of full-
23	time equivalent undergraduate non-Virginia student enrollment is less than 20 percent.
