6	A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 45.2-1717 and 45.2-1720 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the
7	Southwest Virginia Energy and Research Development Authority; powers and duties; Department
8	of Energy and Department of Environmental Quality; report.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That §§ 45.2-1717 and 45.2-1720 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 45.2-1717. (Effective until July 1, 2029) Definitions.
12	As used in this article, unless the context requires a different meaning:
13	"Authority" means the Southwest Virginia Energy Research and Development Authority
14	established pursuant to this article.
15	"Coal mine methane" means methane gas captured and produced from an underground gob area
16	associated with a mined-out coal seam that would otherwise escape into the atmosphere.
17	"Developer" means any private developer of an energy development project.
18	"Energy development project" means an electric generation facility any activity that generates,
19	produces, or stores energy, any energy efficiency system, and any supporting ancillary activities located
20	within Southwest Virginia and includes interests in land, improvements, and ancillary facilities and
21	research, development, commercialization, and deployment activities designated by the Authority to the
22	nonprofit collaborative.
23	"Nonprofit collaborative" means a multi-site nonprofit innovative energy technology testbed
24	established as a collaborative effort of the Department of Energy, the Authority, and the Authority's
25	business partners to support the Authority's purpose through energy technology research, development,
26	commercialization, and deployment.

27	"Southwest Virginia" means the region of the Commonwealth designated as Southwest Virginia
28	in § 22.1-350.
29	"Southwest Virginia Energy Park" means the nonprofit collaborative.
30	§ 45.2-1720. (Effective until July 1, 2029) Powers and duties of the Authority.
31	In addition to the other powers and duties established under this article, the Authority has the
32	power and duty to:
33	1. Adopt, use, and alter at will an official seal;
34	2. Make bylaws for the management and regulation of its affairs;
35	3. Maintain an office at any place within the Commonwealth it designates;
36	4. Accept, hold, and administer moneys, grants, securities, or other property transferred, given, or
37	bequeathed to the Authority, absolutely or in trust, from any source, public or private, for the purposes for
38	which the Authority is established;
39	5. Make and execute contracts and all other instruments and agreements necessary or convenient
40	for the exercise of its powers and functions, including executing contracts and all other instruments and
41	agreements that the Authority deems necessary with the nonprofit collaborative;
42	6. Employ, in its discretion, consultants, attorneys, architects, engineers, accountants, financial
43	experts, investment bankers, superintendents, managers, and any other employees and agents necessary
44	and fix their compensation to be payable from funds made available to the Authority;
45	7. Invest its funds as permitted by applicable law;
46	8. Receive and accept from any federal or private agency, foundation, corporation, association, or
47	person grants, donations of money, or real or personal property for the benefit of the Authority, and receive
48	and accept from the Commonwealth or any other state, from any municipality, county, or other political
49	subdivision thereof, or from any other source, aid or contributions of either money, property, or other
50	things of value, to be held, used, and applied for the purposes for which such grants and contributions may
51	be made;
52	9. Enter into agreements with any department, agency, or instrumentality of the United States or
53	of the Commonwealth and its political subdivisions and with lenders and enter into loans with contracting

54	parties for the purpose of conducting research and development, energy project development, and
55	planning, regulating, and providing for the financing or leasing or assisting in the financing or leasing of
56	any project;
57	10. Do any lawful act necessary or appropriate to carry out the powers granted or reasonably
58	implied in this article;
59	11. Leverage the strength in energy workforce and energy technology research and development
60	of the Commonwealth's public and private institutions of higher education;
61	12. Support the energy development of projects generally, including pump storage hydropower in
62	Southwest Virginia and, energy storage generally, hydrogen production and uses, carbon capture and
63	storage, geothermal energy, advanced wind and solar energy, and advanced reactors and advanced nuclear
64	technologies;
65	13. Promote-the energy development-of renewable energy generation facilities projects on closed
66	power plant sites, brownfield sites, including former coal mine sites, reclaimed coal mine sites, abandoned
67	mine sites lands, and lands adjacent thereto;
68	14. Promote energy workforce development and energy supply chain development, including the
69	development of a manufacturing supply chain cluster for small modular reactors, advanced reactors, and
70	advanced nuclear technologies;
71	15. Assist energy technology research and development by, among other actions, promoting the
72	development of a Southwest Virginia Energy Park;-and
73	16. Identify and work with the Commonwealth's industries and nonprofit partners and, through
74	mutually agreed collaborations, the Commonwealth's research and development partners, in advancing
75	efforts related to energy development in Southwest Virginia; and
76	17. Promote the capture and beneficial use of coal mine methane from active, inactive, and
77	abandoned coal mines as a low-carbon intensity feedstock for manufacturing and energy generation
78	projects located in Southwest Virginia.
