6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 38.2-3407.11:4 of the Code of Virginia, relating to disability insurance;
7	disability arising out of childbirth.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 38.2-3407.11:4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 38.2-3407.11:4. Disability arising out of childbirth; minimum benefit.
11	AEach insurer proposing to issue individual or group accident and sickness insurance policies
12	providing short-term disability income protection coverage whose policies provide coverage for short-
13	term disability arising out of childbirth shall provide coverage for a payable benefit of at least 12 weeks
14	immediately following childbirth for such a disability. Any such policy shall provide 12 weeks of income
15	protection coverage for 12 weeks immediately following childbirth, notwithstanding a disability
16	determination or medical necessity requirement, for any insured who is entitled to 12 weeks of leave
17	immediately following childbirth.
18	B. The provisions of this section shall apply to any policy delivered or issued for delivery in the
19	Commonwealth on and after July 1, 2021.
20	2. That the provisions of this act shall apply to any individual or group accident and sickness
21	insurance policy pursuant to § 38.2-3407.11:4 of the Code of Virginia, as amended by this act,
22	renewed, delivered, or issued for delivery in the Commonwealth on or after July 1, 2023.
