12	that is provided to a patient, as part of the informed consent process, in advance of undergoing such
13	surgeries. The Department of Health Professions shall report its findings and recommendations to the
14	Chairmen of the House Committee on Health and Human Services and the Senate Committee on
15	Education and Health by November 1, 2024.
