10	§ 22.1-273.5. Department; education materials concerning risks of opioids.
11	The Department, in consultation with such stakeholders and experts as it deems necessary or
12	appropriate, shall develop and distribute to each school board age-appropriate and evidence-based
13	education materials concerning the risks to health and safety that are posed by opioids, with a particular
14	focus on the risk of death that is posed by fentanyl. Each school board shall ensure that such materials are
15	distributed to or incorporated into instructional programs for students enrolled in the local school division.
