6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 46.2-1145.1, relating to overweight
7	permits; trucks operated by electric utilities.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-1145.1 as follows:
10	§ 46.2-1145.1. Overweight permits for certain trucks operated by electric utilities.
11	In addition to other permits provided for in this article, the Commissioner, upon written application
12	by an electric utility as defined in § 56-576, shall issue a permit authorizing the electric utility's operation
13	of vehicles used for the construction, operation, or maintenance of electrical facilities and infrastructure
14	upon the highway at gross weights exceeding those set forth in § 46.2-1126. Permits issued hereunder
15	shall specify that vehicles with two axles may have a maximum gross weight of no more than 48,000
16	pounds and a single axle weight of not more than 24,000 pounds and that vehicles with three axles may
17	have a maximum gross weight of not more than 60,000 pounds and a single axle weight of not more than
18	24,000 pounds and a tandem axle weight of not more than 40,000 pounds.
19	The fee for such permit shall be as provided in § 46.2-1140.1.
20	The permit shall not designate the route to be traversed nor contain restrictions or conditions not
21	applicable to other vehicles in their general use of the highways. However, no such permit shall authorize
22	violation of any weight limitation applicable to bridges or culverts, as promulgated and posted in
23	accordance with § 46.2-1130. Nothing contained in this section shall authorize any extension of weight
24	limits provided in § 46.2-1127 for operation on interstate highways. Each vehicle, when loaded according
25	to the provisions of a permit issued under this section, shall be operated at a reduced speed of 10 miles per
26	hour slower than the legal speed limit on any highway with a speed limit above 30 miles per hour.

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
